compassing hundreds of millions of additional acres are scheduled for Alaskan waters over the next five years;

WHEREAS, the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act requires the Secretary of Interior to consider fish and wildlife values, the potential impacts of oil and gas leasing on those resources, and the recommendations of affected states in reaching a decision to offer a portion of the OCS for lease;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has asked the Secretary of Interior to delay Sale 92 until at least 1994 and has placed a 10-year moratorium on any state oil and gas leasing on state submerged lands along the northern Alaska Peninsula because of concern over the need to conserve the area's fisheries and unique wildlife.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the International Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies urges the Secretary of Interior to reconsider OCS Sale 92 and delete the North Aleutian Basin Planning Area from the OCS 1986-1991 five-year leasing schedule; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the International Association urges the Secretary of Interior to delete the North Aleutian Basin from future consideration for leasing until completion of studies to fill critical information needs identified by the state in the joint state, Minerals Management Service, and United Fishermen of Alaska Information Needs Study.
